Carol Wever, presently Director of Change of Pace South Bible studies, has had a long career in spiritual mentoring and Bible teaching. After graduating from Presbyterian Hospital School of Nursing in Philadelphia, she attended Moody Bible Institute in Chicago. Meeting her husband, Wayne, in Alaska, during a summer missions trip, they spent their first four years of marriage at Dallas Seminary where he earned a Masters in Theology. They then returned to Princeton University, N.J. where Wayne graduated four years earlier to assume the Directorship of a campus ministry called the Princeton Evangelical Fellowship (PEF). Working side by side for 27 years, Carol and Wayne mentored undergraduate students in the Bible and Christian living. Carol's particular delight was spending some 20 hours a week, meeting one on one with women students, often going through Romans verse by verse, doing Old Testament Survey or covering a basic doctrine course. God then called them to Lancaster where Wayne became the Director of the Mens' ministries at Water Street Rescue Mission. Carol started Change of Pace South, a women's community Bible study which meets weekly in the southern end of Lancaster County. It has grown from 20 women to an average of 120. Carol has two adult daughters, married, living in Boston and Seattle. Her three grandchildren are her special delight. Her hobbies are hospitality and landscaping. They live in Holtwood and attend New Providence Church of God.
