

#### KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST - THREE DAY CLASS

Welcome to Bethany Christian School's Kindergarten Department. We will be having a meeting before school starts called "Kindergarten Open House." At the meeting we will distribute additional information about our kindergarten day. We will also be available during this time to answer your questions. We are looking forward to meeting you and your child at this time. Specific times for the meeting will be sent to you.

We encourage you to please bring the following items to the parent/student/teacher meeting to be held on an afternoon just a few days before school begins.

<u>COMPOSITION BOOK</u> - Bible verses will be sent home in this book. It is usually black and white with about 70 pages. Put your child's name on the front cover.

SPIRAL NOTEBOOK -Two notebooks with at least 70 pages. Put your child's name on the front cover.

PLASTIC FOLDER - Purchase one folder; it must have two pockets. Label with your child's name.

BIBLE - ENGLISH STANDARD VERSION (ESV) - Label with name.

CRAYOLA CRAYONS -TWO BOXES OF 24 COUNT REGULAR SIZED CRAYONS (DO NOT BUY WASHABLE OR TWIST-UP CRAYONS). Label each box with your child's name.

<u>CRAYOLA MARKERS (THESE ARE WASHABLE)</u>. Again buy the Classic Colors and only label the box of markers, not each individual marker.

<u>GLUE STICKS</u> - Buy the solid sticks not the liquid sticks or office gel, as they are <u>very</u> sticky. One dozen sticks should be sufficient for the entire school year.

PENCIL/CRAYON BOX -It should be approximately 8" by 5". Label the box with your child's name. Please no zipper boxes.

ONE BOX OF 175-COUNT OR MORE TISSUES AND ONE ROLL OF PAPER TOWELS.

LYSOL OR CLOROX WIPES - Two containers to help keep desks sanitary due to eating at our desks. Label with name

<u>SLEEPING MAT</u> - This is for afternoon rest/listening time. DUE TO THE LACK OF STORAGE SPACE, WE MUST HAVE THE THIN THREE-SECTION, BLUE AND RED PLASTIC MATS NOT LARGER THAN 18 INCHES BY 44 INCHES. The thick mats take up too much space. Kindermat is one brand name. No cloth mats are allowed for sanitary reasons. Label with your child's name.

<u>SMALL SIZE BACK PACK</u> - Purchase a regular-sized backpack (no large ones with rollers), one that will hold your child's lunch box, a library book, and papers. Label with your child's name.

LUNCH BOX - Due to spills the thermos must be a flip top. No open drink containers. Label with your child's name.

We encourage you to please bring the following items to the parent/student/teacher meeting to be held on an afternoon just a few days before school begins.

<u>COMPOSITION BOOK</u> - Bible verses will be sent home in this book. It is usually black and white with about 70 pages. Put your child's name on the front cover.

SPIRAL NOTEBOOK -Three notebooks with at least 70 pages. Put your child's name on the front cover.

PLASTIC FOLDER - Purchase one folder; it must have two pockets. Label with your child's name.

BIBLE - ENGLISH STANDARD VERSION (ESV) - Label with name.

CRAYOLA CRAYONS -THREE BOXES OF 24 COUNT REGULAR SIZED CRAYONS (DO NOT BUY WASHABLE OR TWIST-UP CRAYONS). Label each box with your child's name.

<u>CRAYOLA MARKERS (THESE ARE WASHABLE)</u>. Again buy the Classic Colors and only label the box of markers, not each individual marker.

<u>GLUE STICKS</u> - Buy the solid sticks not the liquid sticks or office gel, as they are <u>very</u> sticky. One dozen sticks should be sufficient for the entire school year.

PENCIL/CRAYON BOX -It should be approximately 8" by 5". Label the box with your child's name. Please no zipper boxes.

ONE BOX OF 175-COUNT OR MORE TISSUES AND ONE ROLL OF PAPER TOWELS.

LYSOL OR CLOROX WIPES - Two containers to help keep desks sanitary due to eating at our desks. Label with name

<u>SLEEPING MAT</u> - This is for afternoon rest/listening time. Six large rolls of paper towels (may request more mid-year)

One pack of loose-leaf wide-ruled notebook paper (not college ruled, not spiral bound)

Two large containers of disinfecting wipes
