

# **Bus Service Description**

- Pennsylvania bus services are for Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students and are free-of-charge.
- Maryland bus service is for Preschool through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade students and is \$150 per month per family for round-trip and \$75 per month per family for one-way (cost is pro-rated for families with only children enrolled in three-day programs).
- Students may only use the bus service in the district they reside.
- In the event of inclement weather, BCS will follow Oxford Area Public School's closure decision.
- If you live in a district outside of Oxford Area School District, **bus service will follow your local district**. If your local district has a two-hour delay or is closed due to inclement weather, and BCS is open, *it is your decision* as a parent whether or not you feel that it is safe enough to bring or send your child to school. If you choose to keep your child home for a weather-related reason, he/she will receive an excused absence.
- If BCS is delayed for weather and your local disctrict is not, there will be no morning bus service, exception is Maryland bus.

# Oxford Area School District (OASD)

Regular Bus Service:

- Morning—Students will be picked up by an OASD school bus at their home address or closest bus stop
- Afternoon—Students will be dropped off by an OASD school bus at their home address or closest bus stop

Early Dismissal Days:

- Scheduled—Regular Bus Service will be provided.
- Emergency—Regular Bus Service will be provided.

When Bethany is in session and OASD is not in session:

• Regular Bus Service will be provided (unless OASD's closure on one of the six legal holidays or due to weather).

## Avon Grove School District (AGSD)

Regular Bus Service:

- Morning—Students will be picked up by an AGSD school bus (Middle/High School run) at their home address and brought to Fred S. Engle Middle School. Once there, students will board the AGSD bus for BCS and arrive at BCS approximately 8:00 am.
- Afternoon—Students will board the AGSD bus at BCS by 3:00 pm and proceed to the Penn London Elementary School arriving approximately 3:20 pm. Then there are two options:
  - 1. Students may be picked up by their parents at Penn London Elementary School, or
  - 2. Students will proceed to Fred S. Engle Middle School by 3:30 pm, and may be picked up by their parents or, after a layover, board the AGSD bus that will transport them to their home address.

Early Dismissal Days:

• Scheduled—Regular Bus Service will be provided, except after the Fred S. Engle Middle School stop, a special route (referred to as the "Direct Route") will be used to transport students to their home address.  Emergency—Regular Bus Service will be provided following AGSD inclement weather closure decision. If BCS closes early for an emergency, bus service will be provided.

When Bethany is in session and AGSD is not in session:

• Bus Service will be provided using the Scheduled Early Dismissal plan and the "Direct Route" (unless closure is due to a legal holiday or weather).

#### Solanco School District (SSD) Parents have 3 options

Regular Bus Service:

Option 1

- Morning—Students will be picked up by an SSD school bus/van at their home address or closest bus stop
- Afternoon—Students will be dropped off by an SSD school bus/van at their home address or closest bus stop

Option 2

• Parents can receive a stipend if they choose to drive their students to school (contact SSD for more information).

Option 3

• Parents can receive a stipend if they choose to drive their students to the hub location at Little Britain Elementary School.

Early Dismissal Days:

- Scheduled—No bus service will be provided for the P.M. run.
- Emergency—Regular Bus Service will be provided following **SSD** inclement weather closure decision. If BCS closes early for an emergency, bus service will be provided.

When Bethany is in session and SSD is not in session:

• Regular Bus Service will be provided (unless closure is due to a legal holiday or weather).

## Octorara School District (OSD)

Regular Bus Service:

- Morning—Students will be picked up by an OSD school van at their home address
- Afternoon—Students will be dropped off by an OSD school van at their home address <u>Early Dismissal Days:</u>
  - Scheduled—Regular Bus Service will be provided.
  - Emergency—Regular Bus Service will be provided following **OSD** inclement weather closure decision. If BCS closes early for an emergency, bus service will be provided.

When Bethany is in session and OSD is not in session:

 Regular Bus Service will be provided (unless closure is due to a legal holiday or weather).

## **Maryland Bus**

Regular Bus Service:

- Morning—Students will be picked up by the BCS MD Bus at one of three central locations (Grace Bible Chapel, West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, or the Horst/Meulenberg Farm)
- Afternoon— Students will be picked up by the BCS MD Bus at one of three central locations (Grace Bible Chapel, West Nottingham Presbyterian Church, or the Horst/Meulenberg Farm)
- Early Dismissal Days:
- Scheduled—Regular Bus Service will be provided.
- Emergency—Regular Bus Service will be provided following **Cecil County Public School's** (CCPS) inclement weather closure decision. If BCS closes early for an emergency, bus service will be provided on BCS's schedule.

When Bethany is in session and CCPS is not in session:

• Regular Bus Service will be provided (unless closure is due to weather).
