Monday Mornings: Keep in mind that Monday mornings will be busy with making sure that all of our campers are going to their correct camps and getting settled in for a great camp! Please be on time and don't forget cash for Snack Shop!

Extended Hours: Extended camp hours are designed for campers who are enrolled in programs from 8:30am-3:00pm but need to be picked up after 3:00pm. After care hours are from 3:20pm-6:00pm. You may purchase these services separately. We close promptly at 6:00pm. There will be a mandatory \$1 per minute per camper fee for all campers remaining past the 6:00pm camp closing time.

Lunch/Snacks: Campers must bring their own non-perishable lunch and beverage to camp daily. Campers also must bring a morning and afternoon snack. However, campers will visit our Snack Shop daily where various snack foods may be purchased.
