




# SUMMER READING AND MATH



Below you will find a list of math and reading requirements for students **GOING INTO** 1-8th grades.

<b>1st</b>	Practice addition and subtraction facts to 5, counting to 50, and counting by 5s and 10s to 100.	Students are required to read 15 books to parents, at a rate of 5 books per month. Below a log is provided for tracking and should be returned on the first day of school.
<b>2nd</b>	Addition and subtraction facts 1-10, Counting forward and backward from 1-100, Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s.	Students are required to read 15 books to parents, at a rate of 5 books per month. Below a log is provided for tracking and should be returned on the first day of school.
<b>3rd</b>	Addition and subtraction facts 1 – 20, skip counting by 2-10. Any practice of addition/subtraction with regrouping is a plus.	Box Car Children Book #1 by Gertude Chandler Werner
<b>4th</b>	Practice addition and subtraction facts from 1-20, multiplication facts up to 12, and 4-digit addition and subtraction with regrouping for a test in the first week of school.	The Cricket in Times Square by George Selden. Read as many books as you can for fun this summer and keep a list to bring the first day of school for a sweet treat.
<b>5th</b>	Adding and subtracting 2- and 3-digit numbers, multiplication and division facts up to 12, multiplying and dividing 2-digit numbers.	The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C. S. Lewis
